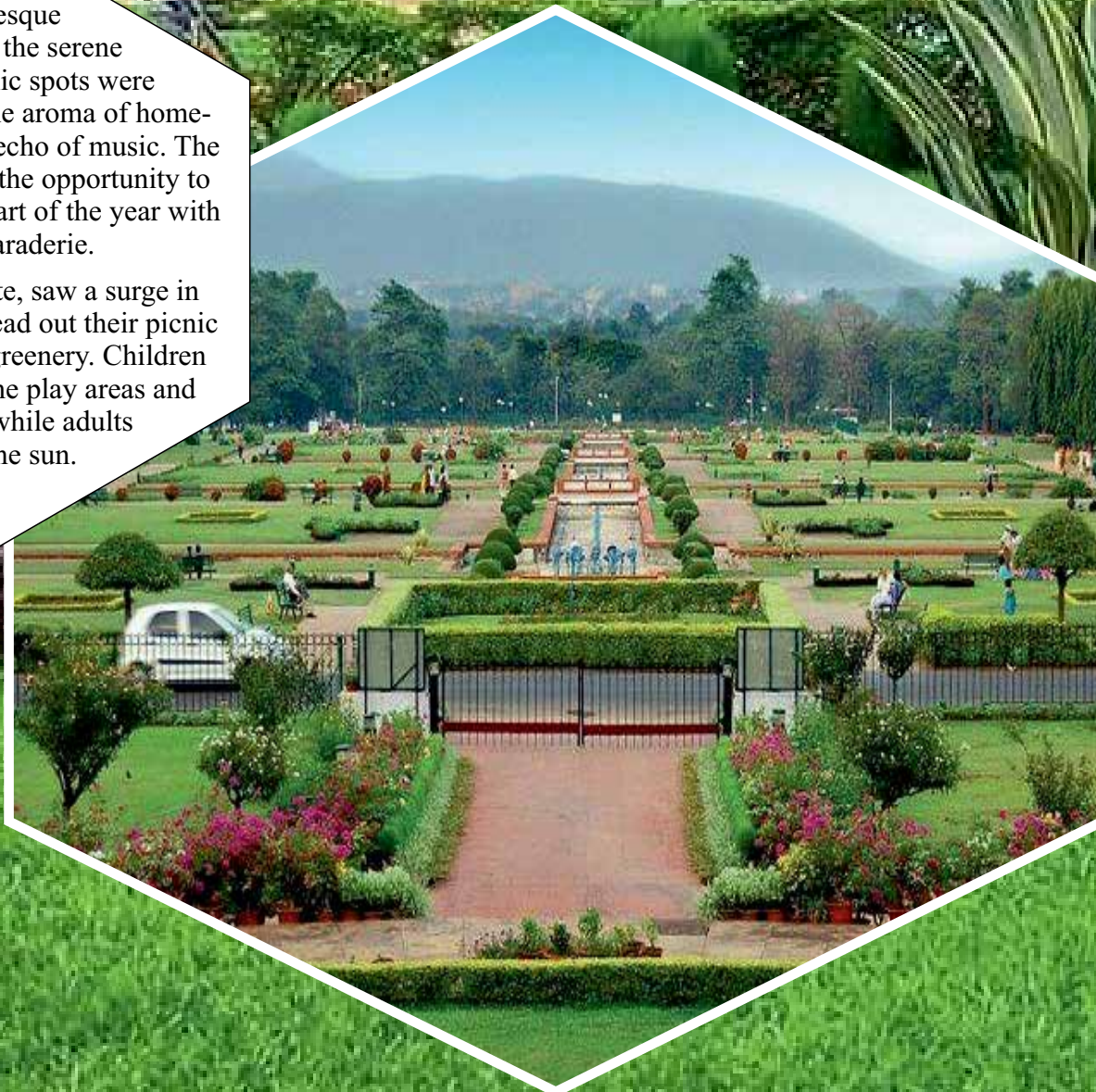


### Picnic Paradise: Exploring the Green Retreats of Jamshedpur!

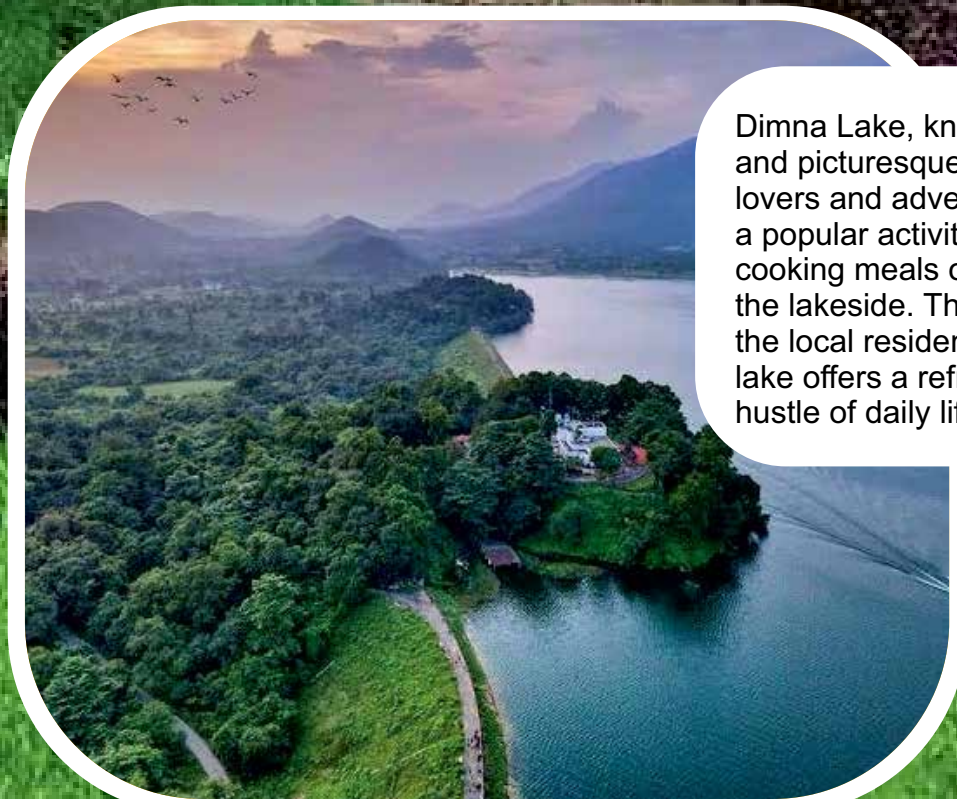
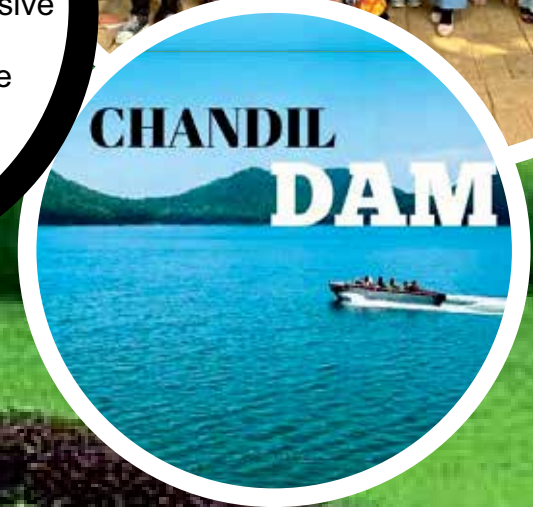

**Q** *What inspired you to start Mutebreak.com?*

2. Many schools couldn't afford the amount to publish the magazine also due to small budget
3. The content poems, stories which students, teacher give to publish in magazine stays inside the campus only and there is no way by which it could reach out of the campus for other could get their hand upon it.
4. Many student give content to publish but due to limited pages they might have to wait for one full year to again give their content to their school magazine to publish and that too they were not guaranteed.
5. Students who have left the school and college have no touch with their institution and also cannot have any reach of their school or college magazine.
6. One school or college have no chance to read other school's or college's magazine as well as every end-user also which don't have any access to any school or college.
7. The content of every student is read by school people itself or by parents only.
8. Students do not get anything in return for their articles and poems and stories.
9. Till today there is no common platform where every institute can create their magazine online and till date no school and college have their own online students' story book or poem book or essay book.

SOLUTIONS WHICH MUTEBREAK.COM HAVE FOR THE STUDENTS:

**Q** *Did you always want to be an entrepreneur, or was there a turning point that led you to start your own venture?*

But to design a software and open my own company was always their in my mind. So I left the job after 4 months only and on 25th May 2008 I opened my own company in the name of KAMROON ENTERPRISES.

**Q** *What are some mistakes you made that other entrepreneurs should avoid?*

**A** Entrepreneurship is a challenging journey, and even the most successful entrepreneurs make mistakes along the way. However, learning from these common pitfalls can help you avoid them and increase your chances of success. In the starting I came across three mistakes which I realise, is that :

- Ignoring cash flow and failing to monitor cash flow or overspending too quickly. I rectified it by creating a detailed financial plan, track expenses, and maintain a cash reserve for emergencies. Focus on profitability and sustainable growth.



- Focusing only on short-term gains by prioritizing quick profits over long-term sustainability and I rectified it by balancing short-term wins with a long-term vision and invested in building a strong brand and customer relationships.
- Fearing failure and being too afraid to take risks or learn from mistakes. I overcome this mistake by embrace failure as a learning opportunity and started taking calculated risks and using setbacks as stepping stones to improve.

**Q** *How did you acquire your first customers/users for Mutebreak.com?*

**A** I played a small trick here. As mutebreak works on subscription model for school and colleges but earlier in the beginning when we launched mutebreak.com our team decided to keep it free and we started doing physical and online promotion. We started visiting school and colleges and startup events. The traffic was good and many people registered their magazine and many registered as reporter to upload their articles. It was a smart step to gather people attention in the beginning and after one year when all the traffic went stable and the amount of uploading of articles went normal we just converted the entire model into a paying subscription, only for magazine and left everyone to join any magazine and upload their articles, poems, story and essay completely free till date.

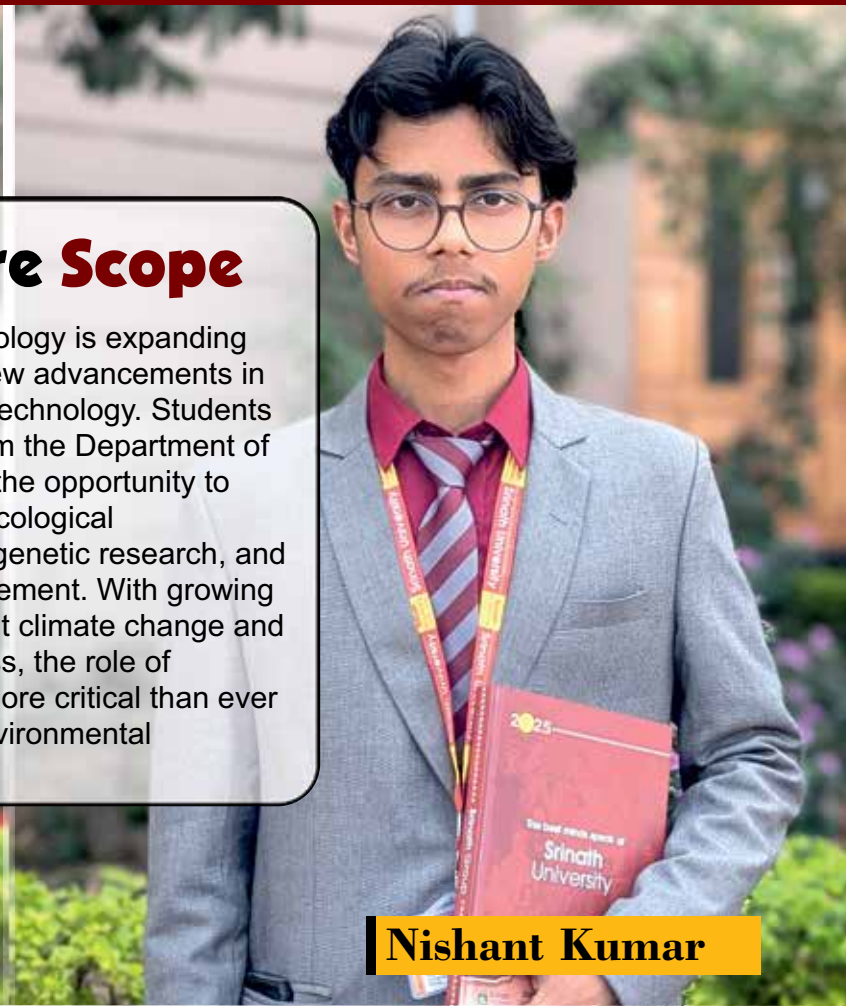

*Truth:* Your native language can actually help in learning English. Comparing grammar structures and vocabulary can make understanding English easier.

## 13. There's a Point Where You Stop Learning

*Truth:* Language learning never truly stops. Even native speakers keep expanding their vocabulary and refining their language skills throughout life.

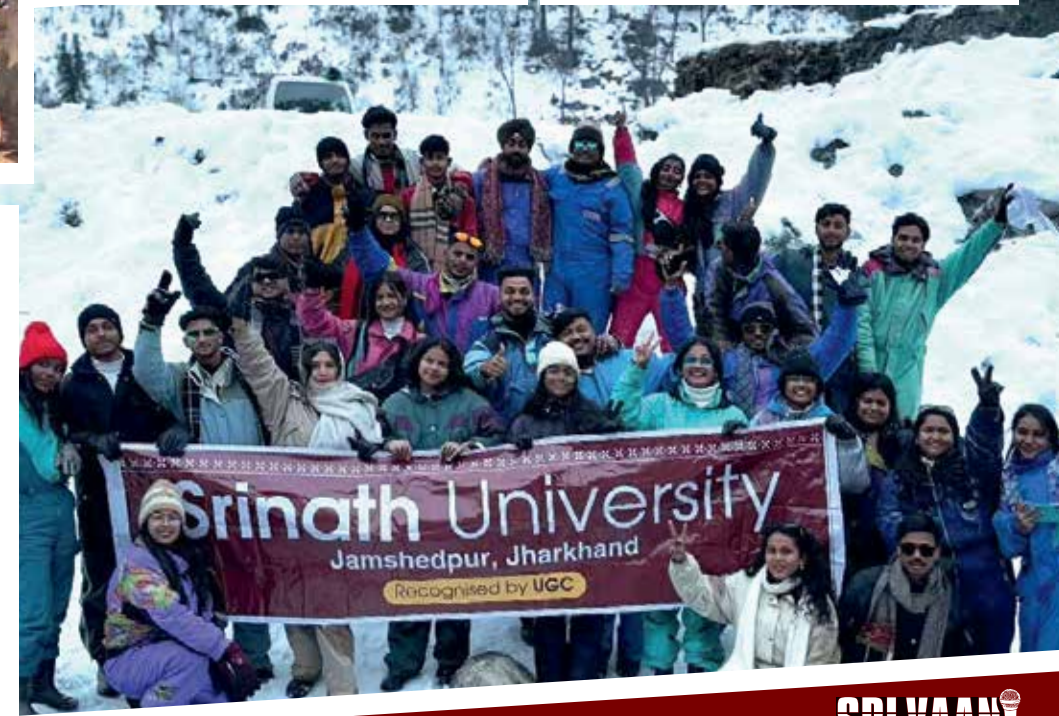
