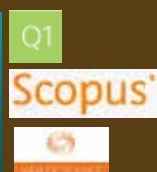

4. Soft Skills and Personality Training:

Regular training in group discussions, presentations, interviews, and business etiquette should be integrated into academic life to build confidence and interpersonal skills.

5. Industry-Academia Interaction:

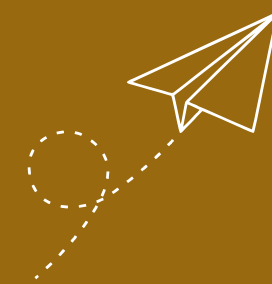
