संस्कृति, संघर्ष और सिनेमा: फिल्म निर्देशक निरंजन कुजूर के साथ खास बातचीत

निरंजन कुमार कुजूर एक प्रख्यात स्वतंत्र फिल्म निर्माता हैं, जो झारखंड के लोहरदगा जिले से आते हैं। उन्होंने सत्यजीत रे फिल्म एंड टेलीविजन इंस्टीट्यूट (SRFTI), कोलकाता से निर्देशन की पढ़ाई की है। वे मुख्य रूप से आदिवासी समुदायों की कहानियों को केंद्र में रखकर फिल्में बनाते हैं और अपनी फिल्मों के माध्यम से क्षेत्रीय भाषाओं जैसे कुड़ख, संथाली, हिंदी, बंगाली और यहां तक कि चीनी भाषा में भी काम कर चुके हैं। उनकी फिल्मों में आदिवासी संस्कृति, पहचान और सामाजिक संघर्षों की गहरी झलक मिलती है।

निरंजन की सबसे चर्चित फिल्मों में से एक है "एदपा काना (Edpa Kana)", जो कुड़ख भाषा में बनाई गई एक लघु फिल्म है। इस फिल्म को 2016 में राष्ट्रीय फिल्म पुरस्कार से सम्मानित किया गया। यह फिल्म मुंबई अंतर्राष्ट्रीय फिल्म महोत्सव में IDPA अवॉर्ड से भी नवाज़ी गई और केरल के IDSFFK में स्पेशल जूरी अवार्ड भी प्राप्त किया। इस फिल्म को चीन के बीजिंग फिल्म अकादमी में भी प्रदर्शित किया गया था. उनकी एक और महत्वपूर्ण फिल्म "पहाड़ा" है, जिसे 44वें अंतर्राष्ट्रीय फिल्म महोत्सव (IFFI) में इंडियन पैनोरमा सेक्शन में चयनित किया गया था। इसके अलावा, उन्होंने "दीबी दुर्गा" नामक एक संथाली म्यूजिक वीडियो भी निर्देशित किया, जिसे बांग्लादेश और मलेशिया में अंतर्राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर प्रदर्शित किया गया। यह वीडियो संथाल आदिवासी महिलाओं के जीवन और संघर्षों को बेहद प्रभावशाली ढंग से चित्रित करता है।

फिल्मों के अलावा, निरंजन ने सामाजिक संदेश देने वाले विज्ञापन फिल्मों में भी अपनी पहचान बनाई है। उनका विज्ञापन "The Spitting Wall", जिसे डाबर रेड पेस्ट के लिए बनाया गया था, को गोआ फेस्ट 2023 में सिल्वर एबी अवॉर्ड प्राप्त हुआ है।

सिनेमा में जाना है ऐसा निर्णय कॉलेज के दोनों में हुआ। जब मैं मणिपाल यूनिवर्सिटी से मास कम्युनिकेशन की पढाई कर रहा था तब वहां सारी चीजें बताई जाती थी जिसमें सिनेमा भी एक था। इसके अलावा एडवर्टाइजमेंट, पब्लिक रिलेशन, टीवी, ग्राउंड रिपोर्टिंग ये सारे विषय पढ़ाए गए थे इसी क्रम में डॉक्यूमेंट्री फिल्में और फिक्शन फिल्म के बारे में पढ़ाया गया। ये सारी चीजें एक्सप्लोर करने के बाद मैंने कॉलेज के दोनों में बिल्कुल अलग तरह की फिल्में देखीं जो आमतौर पर आम जनता के लिए बाहर उपलब्ध नहीं होती। मैंने कॉलेज में वर्ल्ड सिनेमा देखा, कुरुसोवा की रसोमन और ड़ीम्स देखी जिसने मुझे बहुत प्रभावित किया। फिर अदूर गोपालकृष्ण की फिल्में देखी जिसमें अपने समाज की झलक और वास्तविकता देखने को मिलती है। रसोमन फिल्म में भी मुझे झारखंड के दृश्य दिखाई देने लगते थे।

मुझे ऐसा एहसास होने लगा कि फिल्म उतनी भी दूर की चीज नहीं है और सिनेमा में हमारे झारखंड के प्रतिबिंब भी आ सकते हैं। इसका एहसास होना और बाकी के प्रभावों के कारण सिनेमा में काफी इंट्रेस्ट हुआ। सिनेमा में एक आत्मविश्वास की बात भी होती है। जब आप अपने समाज को देखते हैं तो सिनेमा बनाने के प्रति आत्मविश्वास बढ़ता है। इसके अलावे भी कॉलेज के दिनों में फिल्म प्रोजेक्ट होते थे जिसको करते वक्त हम बाहरी दुनिया भूल जाते थे। उसी वक्त से सिनेमा के लिए जरूरी चीजों में ही मेरा ध्यान लगा रहता था।

फिल्म की पढ़ाई के लिए आप कोलकाता स्थित सत्यजीत रे फिल्म एंड टेलीविजन इंस्टीट्यूट गए। फिल्म निर्माण के क्षेत्र में जाना है इसकी प्रेरणा कहां से मिली और इसकी शुरुआत कैसे हुई?

इस संस्थान ने मुझे बहुत ज्यादा प्रभावित किया है। फिल्म स्कूलों की एक विशेष बात होती है कि अपनी कहानी या अपने विचार को सबके सामने सिनेमा के माध्यम से कैसे पहुंचाया जाए और ये सिनेमा किस तरह का आर्ट है ये सिखाया जाता है। फिल्म स्कूलों का यही प्रयास रहता है कि आप अपने विचारों को सिनेमा में कहानी की तरह व्यक्त करना सिख जाएं, तब फिर आप अपनी कहानी को अच्छे से क्राफ्ट करके कह पाते हैं। फिल्म स्कूल आपको इसके योग्य बनाता है। आप यहां एक क्राफ्ट सीखते हैं जहां आपको पता होता है कि ओपनिंग शॉट क्या होता है फिर कैसे फिल्म आगे बढ़ती है। फिल्मों में कहां उतार चढ़ाव होता है ये सारी चीजें

सिखाई जाती हैं। कैमरा से लेकर राइटिंग, साउंड और एडिटिंग तक सब कुछ आप सीखते हैं।

आपकी फिल्मों में झारखंड और बंगाल क्षेत्र की स्थानीय संस्कृति, भाषा, आदिवासी समाज का संघर्ष, उनके अधिकार और सामाजिक विषय शामिल रहते हैं। इस तरह के विषयों में काम करना आपको आकर्षित क्यों करता है?

मुझे नहीं पता कि आपके सवाल को मैं और कितना समय तक जी पाता हूं या आगे चल कर मैं इसपर कितना अमल कर पाऊंगा पर अभी तक जो फोर्स मुझे इस ओर लिए जा रही है वह है हमारे समाज की सभ्यता और जो इसका यथार्थ है जिसकी आज के साहित्य और सिनेमा में कमी है। इसी कमी को भरना है और जो हमारा सामाजिक और आर्थिक यथार्थ है ये सिनेमा में दिखना चाहिए।

दूसरी बात है कि बाहर के लोग जब हमारे आदिवासी समाज के बारे में वर्णन कर रहे होते हैं तो वो हमारे बारे में दूर से सोचते हुए एक अलग तरह का वर्णन करते हैं। एक तो ऐसे ही आदिवासी समाज पर बहुत कम फिल्में बनती हैं और उसमें भी यदि गलत चित्रण हो जाता है तो दुनिया में आपकी छवि खराब हो जाती। ऐसे में जो भी फिल्मकार हैं उसमें कुछ ऐसे जरूर होने चाहिए जो आपके समाज और इसके यथार्थ का सही चित्रण कर सकें। अभी तक मैं इसी प्रयास में लगा हूं और लगातार आगे चल रहा हूं ताकि जब भी कोई व्यक्ति इंटरनेट या यूट्यूब में ढूंढे कि यह समाज कैसा है तो उसे उसका वास्तविक चित्रण देखने को मिले। आदिवासी समाज कैसे रहता है, इसकी बोलचाल कैसी है, कैसे अपने रिश्ते निभाता है, कैसे प्रेम करता है ये सब बिना किसी तामझाम के दिखाई दे। अब आपको कुछ फिल्में इस तरह की जरूर दिखाई देंगी जिसमें कुछ फिल्में मैं बना रहा हूं, कुछ सेराल मुर्मू बना रहे हैं, रवि राज मुर्मू हैं, रंजीत उरांव हैं, राकेश हैं सब लोग इसपर कम कर रहे हैं।

झारखंड और पूर्वी भारत की फिल्मों को मेनस्ट्रीम सिनेमा में उतनी जगह नहीं मिलती है, आप इस क्षेत्र की सिनेमा को किस तरह आगे बढ़ते देखना चाहते हैं?

मैं तो चाहूंगा कि हमारे यहां का सिनेमा डेवलप हो और हम अपनी कहानी को खुद कहें तो ज्यादा बेहतर होगा। हमारी कहानी कोई बाहर से आकर न कहे। बॉलीवुड का जो

इतिहास रहा है उसमें आप देखेंगे कि वहां साउथ का जो कैरेक्टर होता है उसे बहुत मोडिफाई करके फनी कैरेक्टर बना दिया जाता है। आपने पडोसन फिल्म देखी होगी जिसमें एक गाना है ' मेरे सामने वाली खिड़की पे कोई चांद का टुकड़ा रहता है ' उसमें महमूद का जो किरदाद है वह सच नहीं हैं। इन फिल्मों की वजह से उत्तर भारत के लोग साउथ वालों को अईयो रामा जैसा समझने लगते हैं जो सही नहीं है। उसी तरह से बॉलीवुड में बंगाली कैरेक्टर का चित्रण भी बहुत फनी और और अलग बना देते हैं। अगर आप बॉलीवुड को सेंटर में रख देंगे तो जो भी कल्चर उनसे दूर होता है उसका ठीक- ठीक चित्रण नहीं करते हैं। अब ओटीटी और सिनेमा के जरिए हमें पता चल गया है कि रियल में साउथ के लोगों का हिंदी एक्सेंट कैसा होता है और अब वो पुराना नकली वाला कैरेक्टर नहीं चलता है। अब बॉलीवुड में साउथ के कैरेक्टर के लिए सच में साउथ इंडियन आर्टिस्ट को कास्ट करना पड़ता है ताकि उसमें रीयल इफेक्ट आए।

आज ये बहुत जरूरी है कि हमारा क्षेत्रीय सिनेमा बड़े स्तर पर निकल कर आए नहीं तो गैंग्स ऑफ वासेपुर या यूपी बिहार की तरह ही झारखंड भी रिप्रेजेंट होता रहेगा। हमारा झारखंड, यूपी और बिहार से बहुत अलग है, यहां की संस्कृति और यहां का समाज बिल्कुल ही इन राज्यों से अलग है। हमें इस बात पर ध्यान देना होगा कि झारखंड की फिल्में डेवलप हों। तब जाकर हमारा रिप्रेजेंटेशन अच्छा होगा। हमें कमर्शियल सिनेमा के साथ साथ इंडस्ट्री में अपनी मजबूत उपस्थिति दर्ज करानी होगी। तमिल संगीत के बिट्स पर बॉलीवुड काम कर रही है उसी तरह झारखंड के बिट्स भी बहुत पारंपरिक हैं जिसपर काम करने की जरूरत है।

हर फिल्ममेकर में समाज के प्रति संवेदनशीलता होनी चाहिए, आपमें इसकी समझ कैसे विकसित हुई?

मुझे लगता है कि यह आजीवन चलने वाली एक प्रक्रिया है मेरे लिए यह कहना थोड़ा मुश्किल होगा कि कब मेरे अंदर यह मैच्योरिटी और संवेदनशीलता आई। मैं आज जो कर

रहा हूं या जब भी आप पांच साल की पहले की चीजों को पलट कर देखोगे तो आपको हमेशा ही लगेगा कि आप उस वक्त मेच्योर नहीं थे। कई चीजों पर आपका अवेयरनेस बहुत जरूरी होता है। आपके आस-पास कौन-कौन सी चीज घटित हो रही है वह सिर्फ आपको मीडिया के माध्यम से पता नहीं चलेगा आपको इसके लिए पढना पड़ेगा और थोड़ा दूर-दूर तक देखना पड़ेगा।

बहुत बार आपको गांव में कहानी ढूंढनी पडेगी ल, कुछ चीज आपको साहित्य में ढूंढनी पड़ेगी। इन सारी चीजों में आपको एक चेतना दिखाई पड़ेगी जिससे आप मैच्योर होते हैं। ऐसा हो सकता है कि अलग-अलग इंसान को अलग-अलग चीज प्रभावित करेंगे मगर वैल्यू सब में है। सिनेमा के अलावे जो भी आर्ट फॉर्म है उसमें आप अपने अनुभव को उकेर सकते हैं। घूमने, पढ़ने और लगातार लोगों से मिलने के कारण एक्सपोजर बढ़ता है। जब आप चीजों को ऑब्जर्व करेंगे तो अपने आप संदेवनशील बनते चले जाएंगे।

आज के युवा फिल्ममेकर्स जो सिनेमा बना रहे हैं या सिनेमा बनाने की चाहत रखते हैं उन्हें आप क्या संदेश देना चाहेंगे?

कैसे भी करके फिल्में बनाएं फिलहाल तो यही मेरा गोल है। फिल्ममेकर कई बार अपनी फिल्मों में निगोशिएशन करता है क्योंकि सिर्फ एक आदमी फिल्म नहीं बना रहा होता है, जो लोग पैसा लगा रहे हैं उनकी भी अपनी सोच होती है मगर मेरा प्रयास रहता है इन सब के बावजूद सिनेमा में जो मूल बातें है उसे बनाए रखूं। सिनेमा की मूल बातों को मैं कमर्शियली भी रखना चाहता हूं इससे सिनेमा का रीच बढेगा और ग्रासरूट लेवल पर फंडिंग भी बढेगी।

ज्यादा सीरियस सिनेमा बहुत लोगों तक नहीं पहुंच पाती ऐसे में मेरा प्रयास रहता है कि उसको थोड़ा सा कमर्शियल करके अपने तरीके से लोगों तक पहुंचा पाऊं। बेहतर स्क्रिप्ट के साथ एक फीचर फिल्म बनाऊं जिससे मैं ज्यादा से ज्यादा लोगों तक पहुंच पाऊं और थोड़ा एंटरटेन भी कर सकूं। अभी फिलहाल मेरे कई फिल्म प्रोजेक्ट चल रहे हैं लेकिन आने वाले समय में और कुछ बड़ा करने का प्रयास रहेगा। झारखंड में ऐसे भी फिल्मेकिंग कम ही होती है लेकिन आने वाले समय में हालात सुधरेंगे। अभी झारखंड में सिनेमा को लेकर बहुत सारी चर्चाएं चल रही हैं और थोड़ा माहौल भी बनता हुआ दिख रहा है। आने वाले समय में झारखंड की सिनेमा और भी बेहतर हो जाएगी।

आप भविष्य में आगे किस विषय पर काम करना चाहते हैं? आपके नजर में एक फिल्ममेकर की सबसे बड़ी जिम्मेदारी क्या होनी चाहिए?

नए लोगों को मैं यही टिप्स देना चाहुंगा कि ज्यादा से ज्यादा **30** शॉर्ट फिल्में बनाएं। शॉर्ट फिल्म्स बहुत पावरफुल होते हैं जिसकी समझ यहां के स्थानीय फिल्मकारों को कम है

इसीलिए शायद वो बहुत ज्यादा शॉर्ट फिल्म्स नहीं बना रहे हैं। जो फिल्ममेकर शॉर्ट फिल्म बना- बनाकर आगे बढेगा वह बहुत दूर तक जाएगा। शॉर्ट फिल्म बनाने के लिए बहुत संसाधनों की जरूरत नहीं पड़ती है। फिक्शन के अलावा आप छोटी डाक्यूमेंट्री 15 से 20 मिनट की बना सकते हैं। हर फिल्म के बाद सीनियर लोगों से फीडबैक जरूर लें जो आपकी सिनेमा को और बेहतर करेगा। इन चीजों को फिर आप अपनी अगली फिल्म में ठीक करेंगे।

झारखंड में फंडिंग की समस्या तो रही है लेकिन यदि आप बहुत बेहतर काम करते हैं, आपमें अच्छा टैलेंट है या आपने जो काम किया है उसमें बहुत पोटेंशियल है तो आप लंबी फिल्मों पर काम कर सकते हैं जो एक घंटे के ऊपर की होगी तो फिर कुछ प्रोड्यूसर्स झारखंड में है जो आपकी मदद कर सकते हैं। सबसे ज्यादा जरूरी है कि आप लघु फिल्में बनाएं। बिना शॉर्ट फिल्म बनाए बड़ी फिल्मों में जंप करना सही नहीं होता है। झारखंड में मुझे छोटी फिल्मों का एक बाजार बनता हुआ दिख रहा है।

झारखंड फिल्म पॉलिसी बनी है, कुछ बाहर की फिल्में यहां शूट भी हुई हैं लेकिन स्थानीय कलाकारों और फिल्ममेकर्स को इसका इतना फायदा नहीं मिला है। आपके अनुसार इसकी क्या वजहें हैं?

उ0 इस पॉलिसी में बहुत कुछ सुधार होने की गुंजाइश है। सबसे जरूरी चीज है कि हमारे जो स्थानीय फिल्म मेकर्स हैं उनकी फिल्मों का सही मूल्यांकन किया जाए। इन फिल्मों को सब्सिडी का देने का अनिवार्य रूप से प्रावधान होना चाहिए और ये काम अविलंब होना चाहिए। ऐसा नहीं होना चाहिए कि एक बार फिल्म बना और फिर दूसरी फिल्म के लिए तीन से पांच साल तक इंतजार करो। यह प्रावधान उन भाषाओं में लागू होना चाहिए जहां पैसे लगाने के लिए प्रोड्यूसर्स की कमी


कुछ आदिवासी भाषाएं हैं जिनका बाजार अभी तक बन नहीं पाया है। जो फिल्ममेकर आदिवासी भाषाओं में काम कर रहे हैं ऐसा देखा गया है कि उनके लिए कोई इन्वेस्टर ही नहीं है। सब्सिडी की बात तो वहां आती है जहां इन्वेस्टर्स होते हैं मगर झारखंड में मूल बात है कि फिल्म बनाने के लिए जिस पूंजी की आवश्यकता होती है वह उपलब्ध नहीं है ऐसे में फिल्ममेकर्स के लिए फंडिंग का प्रावधान भी होना चाहिए।

विश्व के कई देशों में आदिवासी भाषाओं पर फिल्म बनाने के लिए फंडिंग की व्यवस्था है इसमें पेसिफिक आईलैंड के कई देश हैं, इसमें ग्रीनलैंड, ऑस्ट्रेलिया, कनाडा, अमेरिका, मेक्सिको और अर्जेंटीना जैसे देश शामिल हैं। यहां तक कि हमारे देश में भी केरल राज्य में इस तरह की फंडिंग हो रही है। केरल में आदिवासी फिल्म मेकर्स को आदिवासी भाषाओं में फिल्म बनाने के लिए फंडिंग मिल रही है। केरल में आदिवासी जनसंख्या एक प्रतिशत के आसपास है फिर भी वहां फंडिंग की जा रही है ऐसे में झारखंड में आदिवासियों की संख्या काफी अधिक है इसलिए यहां यह प्रावधान लागू होना चाहिए। झारखंड के फिल्मकारों ने अपने आप को प्रव भी किया है लेकिन फिर भी वे फिल्म नहीं बना पा रहे हैं ऐसे में सरकार की जिम्मेदारी होती है कि इन फिल्मों की फंडिंग करे।

देश में पैरेलल सिनेमा के विकास में भी एनएफडीसी जैसी संस्था का गठन किया गया था जिसने उस दौर में फिल्मों की फंडिंग की थी। अगर आप देश में सिनेमा का स्तर सुधारना चाहते हैं या सिनेमा का विकास करना चाहते हैं तो सरकार को छोटी फिल्मों को भी प्रमोट करना पड़ेगा। लघु फिल्मों को फंड करने से नए टैलेंट के आने की संभावना ज्यादा हो जाती है। नए लोगों को फिल्म बनाने का मौका ज्यादा मिलता है। जब सिनेमा में प्रयोग होने लगते हैं तो नया तरह का कंटेंट देखने को मिलता है।
