

# **Cultural Harmony** Through Temples



Rankini Mandir - Jadugora, Jamshedpur




#### The Living Stone of Jadugoda: Rankini Temple

The Rankini Temple of Jadugoda, nestled between the Dalma Hills and Subarnarekha River, embodies a fusion of tribal faith and Hindu tradition. Rooted in the Bhumij tribe's worship of a black living stone revered as Maa Rankini, an incarnation of Goddess Kali or Durga, the temple carries a rich yet intense history. Once associated with rituals of human sacrifice suppressed by the British in the 19th century, it has transformed into a center of peaceful devotion. Today, the sacred site draws countless pilgrims from Jharkhand, Odisha, and West Bengal, who come to seek Maa Rankini's divine blessings.

#### **Jamshedpur Crown Jewel:** The Bhuvaneshwari Temple

The Bhuvaneshwari Temple, a serene retreat from Jamshedpur's bustle, was founded in 1978 by Swami Rangarajan after a divine vision of Goddess Bhuvaneshwari. Built in the Dravidian style, its 64-foot Rajagopuram stands tall as a spiritual landmark. Beyond being a sacred shrine, it offers panoramic views of the Steel City and the Dalma Hills, attracting devotees and visitors alike. People climb its steps seeking peace, prayer, and scenic beauty, while photographers find it equally captivating. During Navaratri, the temple radiates devotion with music, rituals, and celebrations of Shakti, making it a cultural, spiritual, and visual crown jewel of Jamshedpur.



#### A Divine Abode: Sonari's Sai Baba Temple

Sonari's Sai Baba Temple, near the CH Area petrol pump, is often called Jamshedpur's mini-Shirdi. Conceived in 1998 and completed in 2012 by the Sri Sai Centre, it features lotus-inspired architecture and promotes Sai Baba's message of universal devotion. Managed by a multi-religious committee, it symbolizes harmony across faiths. Beyond worship, the temple is a center of service, hosting poor-feeding programs and celebrating Independence Day with underprivileged children. The sanctum, adorned with flowers and resonating with hymns, offers peace and reflection. Blending spirituality, service, and serenity, the temple stands as a cherished landmark of faith in the Steel

#### **Bistupur Timeless Heart:** The Ram Mandir

The Ram Mandir in Bistupur, officially Andhra Bhakta Sree Rama Mandiram, has stood as a spiritual landmark since 1919. Initially a shed built by Andhra workers, it grew into a grand temple with Tata Steel's support and blessings from leaders like Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose. Marking its centenary in 2019, the temple unveiled a reconstructed gopuram. Beyond worship, it serves the community through pujas, bhajans, charity, and education. Festivals like Ram Navami, Brahmotsavam, Vaikuntha Ekadashi, and the grand Rath Yatra draw thousands. With its prasadam tradition and service, the temple remains Bistupur's spiritual anchor, uniting faith, culture, and history.

## Sample Answer for some Interview Questions

**1.** Two sample answers for the interview questions - why should I hire you?

#### Sample Answer 1: For a Professional/Corporate Role (e.g., Marketing, Finance, Admin)

"You should hire me because I bring a combination of proven skills and a strong work ethic that align perfectly with this role. I've successfully managed similar projects in my previous role, where I increased campaign engagement by 25% in just six months. I'm also someone who takes initiative and adapts quickly to challenges — whether it's picking up a new tool or solving a time-sensitive problem. I believe I can bring not just competence, but real results and a collaborative mind set to your team from day one."

#### Sample Answer 2: For a Technical Role (e.g., Software Developer, Engineer, Data Analyst)

"You should hire me because I have the technical skills and problem-solving mindset that this role demands. In my previous job, I led the redesign of a legacy system that improved performance by 40% and reduced maintenance time by half. #### Sample Answer 2: Skill-Focused & Value-Driven (For Team Players or Specialists)

"Five years from now, I see myself as a well-rounded expert in my field, someone who's made a consistent impact through reliable performance and strong collaboration. I'd like to be known as someone people can count on — whether it's solving tough problems, training new team members, or contributing to innovation. I'm committed to continuous learning and would love to grow within a company that values both individual growth and teamwork."

**3.** Two sample answers for the interview questions - Why did you pursue your respective course?

#### Sample Answer 1: Passion-Driven

"I chose my course because I've always had a strong interest in how things work, especially in [subject area, e.g., technology/business/science]. From a young age, I enjoyed problem-solving and exploring how systems function, which naturally led me to pursue a degree in [your course]. The course allowed me to deepen my understanding and gave me handson experience, which confirmed that I was on the right path. It was the perfect fit for my interests and longterm goals."

#### Sample Answer 2: Career-Focused

"I pursued this course because it aligned well with my career aspirations. I wanted to build a strong foundation in [mention key subject or field], knowing that it would open doors in industries I was interested in. For example, this course helped me gain practical skills in [specific tools, concepts, or areas], which are highly relevant to the roles I'm applying for now. It was a strategic decision that has prepared me well for the challenges of the professional world."
