



triumph that inspire students to strive for excellence both on and off the field.



Bhatia Parks The Green Escape of Kadma



He emphasized the importance of empowering startups through collaboration, mentorship, and sustainable business practices. His story stands as an inspiring example of leadership, perseverance, and commitment to driving positive change through entrepreneurship.

Every entrepreneur starts with an idea how did your first business idea come to

My first business idea was born out of a very personal and local problem. When I shifted to Ranchi from my hometown in 2018, I suffered a lot trying to find a reliable electrician for a small assignment. This led to a crucial realization: there was a significant gap in the market for organized, trustworthy, online handyman services.

We converted this frustration into a solution and started HomeCareIndia. The idea was not just to connect, but to offer a verified, quality-controlled service. This concept was quickly recognized: it was selected by the State Evaluation Board of the Jharkhand Government, incubated at ABVIL, and recognized by Startup India, Startup Jharkhand, and MSME. Solving that one small personal problem laid the groundwork for my first recognized venture.

> Entrepreneurship often involves uncertainty. How did you handle the fear of failure and financial risks?

I've always believed that uncertainty and failure are simply non-negotiable parts of life and business. The critical factor is not if you will face them, but how you handle them and what you learn.

> Initially, I must admit, I wasn't deeply concerned with complex financial risk modeling. I trusted my

decision, took the leap, and started. That early confidence was crucial. However, as time went on, I made mistakes and had setbacks. These experiences became my strongest foundation. Now, I understand that the true way to handle financial risk is through self-correction and learning from every misstep. This practical, real-world education is far more valuable than any theoretical knowledge.

How do you maintain resilience and motivation when things don't go as planned?

I consider myself a hardcore positive thinker. My philosophy is simple: if something goes wrong, it means there is an unexplored chance to do something better. How you react to the circumstances around you defines your attitude, your perception, and ultimately, your outcome. I believe you are entirely responsible for your attitude.

My motivation draws immense strength from the Bhagavad Gita. Its teachings gave me a powerful foundation to maintain a positive mindset and to find clarity and purpose in every situation, especially when plans derail. It is this inner strength that fuels my resilience.


What role did mentorship and networking play in your growth as an entrepreneur?

In the earlier days, accessible mentorship in Jharkhand was scarce. I had to learn the basics through my own mistakes. However, I gradually began to connect with people within my community and profession. This eventually led me to understand the true power of Mentorship and Networking.

The COVID-19 pandemic, ironically, was a turning point. While the world was shut down, I used that time to immerse myself in exploring and learning new things about the entrepreneurial ecosystem. It was during this period of crisis that I initiated "Project Grihini," a venture designed specifically for

women empowerment, successfully adding almost 350 women to our portal. This experience underscored the value of networking and community building—the very factors that helped me convert a crisis into an opportunity for impact.



As a leader, how do you build and maintain a motivated, innovative team?



In my view, a true leader is someone who does first and shows the path to others. While I don't focus on the title of "Leader," I understand what people want and need from

me.

My philosophy is rooted in a simple but powerful principle: "Give the same respect and love to others that you expect from them." For me, every single person in the organization is equally important, from the CEO to the office assistant. If you want to understand this reality, just think about a CEO's day without the smooth functioning of their most foundational staff. To build a motivated team, you must create a culture of mutual respect and ensure everyone feels their contribution is vital.



How do you see Jharkhand's startup ecosystem evolving in the next few years?



We must first be clear on what an "Ecosystem" truly is. Many entrepreneurs mistakenly believe that only government support defines the ecosystem, which is a limiting perception.

An ecosystem is built by the dedicated people, groups, organizations, and institutions that are committed to the upliftment of startups. The government is an essential supportive system, but the true ecosystem emerges from the density of these dedicated individuals and institutions. I believe the future of Jharkhand lies in the strengthening and integration of these non-governmental players. In the next few years, we will see a significant evolution as these groups connect more formally, creating a vibrant, supportive environment that will foster robust, large-scale ventures.



What role is JEA playing in empowering local entrepreneurs and youth of Jharkhand?



Currently, there is a clear deficit in the cohesive startup ecosystem within our state. We, at the Jharkhand Entrepreneurs

Association (JEA), are striving to bridge this gap by actively connecting people, groups, organizations, and institutions to cultivate a truly favorable state for entrepreneurship.

Our core mission is to shorten the learning curve for local founders. All the knowledge and hardearned experience that we, as JEA members, have gained over the years—the successes, the mistakes, and the market insights—we want to pass on. If our collective experience can effectively shorten a fouryear entrepreneurial struggle into a two-year journey, that will be the greatest achievement for all of us as JEA Members and a huge win for the state.



How important is failure in the process of success?

Failure is paramount. It is what makes you learner and keeps you humble. If you



achieve success too easily and too quickly, there is a high chance you will lose it just as fast, precisely because you haven't been through the rigorous process necessary to learn the fundamental lessons.

WORDS OF WISDOM

In my view, success is not a destination, but a daily process of being better than before. While you have milestones, if you haven't learned from and enjoyed the process and the journey, you haven't earned anything truly lasting. Failure is the necessary instructor in this classroom of continuous improvement.



What mindset or habits have been your biggest strength as an entrepreneur?

My biggest strength can be summarized in a single phrase: A Positive Mindset.

In daily life, challenges are inevitable, regardless of whether you are a student, an employee, an entrepreneur, or a family person. What defines you, and how much that problem will affect you, is how you choose to approach your difficulties and turn them in your favor by responding positively. This unwavering commitment to seeing the good, finding the opportunity, and responding constructively is what keeps me moving forward every single day.



If you could give one message to young aspiring entrepreneurs from Jharkhand, what would it be?



My message is simple and essential: Don't pursue entrepreneurship just for a title, fame, or money.

These things are fleeting and will perish one day. Instead, start because you want to be a changemaker—because you are solving a problem that appeals to the masses and can genuinely create a positive shift in your community or industry. In the hardest of days, when everything seems to be going wrong, this core motivation—this purpose to solve

Career modelling is a strategic process that helps individuals—especially students—understand, explore, and plan their career paths by visualizing the steps, skills, and experiences needed to reach their professional goals. It involves mapping out different career options, identifying required competencies, and creating a roadmap from education to employment.

What Does Career Modelling Involve?

1. Self-Assessment

- o Interests, strengths, values, and personality.
- o Tools: MBTI, Holland Codes, career quizzes.

2. Career Exploration

- o Researching various career options based on assessment.
- o Looking into job roles, industries, growth opportunities, and future relevance.

3. Skill Mapping

- o Identifying the skills needed for a desired career.
- o Understanding gaps and how to fill them (courses, internships, certifications).

4. Pathway Visualization

- o Creating a step-by-step plan (education \rightarrow internships \rightarrow entrylevel jobs \rightarrow career goals).
- o Includes alternate pathways for flexibility.

5. On-going Guidance and Reflection

- o Adapting the plan as interests or industries evolve.
- o Using mentors, coaches, or digital platforms for continuous feedback.

- 6. Reassess yearly and adjust the plan.

Industrial Visit of Chemistry Department

B.Sc. & M.Sc. Chemistry students of **Sringth** University had an enriching visit to TATA PIGMENTS LTD., Jamshedpur on 4th September 2025. During the visit, students learned how liquor effluent from Steel Plants is processed to produce pigments (Red & Yellow). They got handson exposure to the Plant area where the actual process is carried out and explored the R&D Laboratory, where they were introduced to the testing of purity in finished products. This visit gave our students a golden opportunity to understand the realworld applications of chemistry in a core chemical processing plant.




