In our **Shakshaatkar** segment, **Sumit Kumar**, Director at **Visapen** and a proud alumnus of NIT Jalandhar, shared his perspectives on leadership and technological innovation. With a strong foundation in engineering and a vision for driving purposeful change, he highlighted the importance of adaptability and solution-oriented thinking in today's competitive landscape. His journey reflects the strength of determination and the value of a forward-focused mindset in shaping impactful leadership.

Q Sir, could you share your professional journey and what inspired you to start Visapen?

A My professional journey began at **NIT Jalandhar**, where four years of engineering didn't just give me a degree—it shaped my mindset. The NIT environment teaches you how to think analytically, solve problems systematically, and push yourself even when there is no clear instruction manual. These habits stayed with me long after graduation.

After NIT, I spent my few years as an aspirant of Indian Armed Forces and did my contributions too for some glorious days but afterwards I spent years working across **travel-tech and global mobility operations**. This was the phase that silently built the foundation for Visapen. While working in this field, I repeatedly encountered a very disturbing pattern: young Indians with dreams of working abroad were constantly misled by unregulated agents. Most of them had:

- no awareness of the process
- no idea about documents
- no clarity about employers
- no protection against fraud
- no access to structured training or financing

I interacted with students who had lost lakhs of rupees to fake agents. I met parents who were terrified of the entire “abroad” journey because there was no trustworthy guidance. And I saw talented youth give up on international opportunities simply because they couldn't afford the initial payment.

This is what pushed me to build Visapen.

Visapen didn't come from ambition; it came from

frustration with a broken system and the desire to fix it. I wanted to create a platform where:

- the student is protected
- the process is transparent
- employers are verified
- finances don't become a barrier
- and the entire journey is structured end-to-end

That intention is what became Visapen — a system where **global mobility meets ethics, technology, and accessibility**.

Q How did Visapen start, and what vision drives the organization today?

Visapen started with a very simple idea:

A Give Indian youth a clear, transparent, step-by-step pathway to work abroad.

Initially, we focused only on documentation assistance. But the demand, the problems we saw, and the positive responses pushed us to expand aggressively.

Today, Visapen is evolving into a **full-stack global mobility ecosystem** that integrates:

Language Training Partnerships

A1–B1 level German language programs via verified partners, with LMS and API support.

MEA-Authorized Recruitment Execution

Working with government-authorized organizations like Magic Billion to ensure legal, safe, compliant pathways.

Employer Networks Across Europe

Access to employers in Germany, Poland, Lithuania, Czech Republic, Romania, and more.

NBFC-Backed Financing Models

India's first “train now, pay later” model for global mobility — making international careers financially accessible.

AI-Based Documentation Automation

Reducing human dependency, minimizing errors, and speeding up visa processing.

Academic Pipeline

Partnering with schools, polytechnics, universities, and ITIs to create a **structured student funnel**.

Our vision is bold and very clear:

To make working abroad accessible to every committed Indian, regardless of their financial background or geographical location.

We want Visapen to become the *Zomato of work permits* — reliable, transparent, and easy to use.

Q What challenges does the industry currently face, and how is Visapen addressing them?

A This industry has deep-rooted problems. Let me break it into three major challenges:

1. Lack of Verified Pathways &

Employer Transparency

Students often depend on WhatsApp messages, verbal promises, and unverified intermediaries. This is the biggest reason for fraud.

How Visapen solves this:

- We work only through **MEA-authorized** partners.
- Employers are verified and documented.
- Every candidate gets a **full transparency sheet** with timelines, employer details, and steps.

2. High Upfront Cost & No Financing Options

Language training, visa filing, documentation, and travel require money.

A lot of deserving students simply cannot afford the upfront cost.

How Visapen solves this:

- Tie-ups with NBFCs to provide **education-style loans** for global mobility.
- EMI starts *after the student reaches abroad and starts earning*.
- This reduces entry barriers drastically.

3. Lack of Structured Guidance and Process Clarity

There is no single place where a student can understand:

- What documents are needed
- Which country is suitable
- What is the timeline
- What salary to expect
- What are the real risks

How Visapen solves this:

We built a **step-by-step, app-based funnel** that guides the candidate from: registration → language → employer → interview → documentation → visa → deployment.

We are replacing guesswork with **clarity** and replacing agents with **systems**.

Q What future goals or expansions can we expect from Visapen?

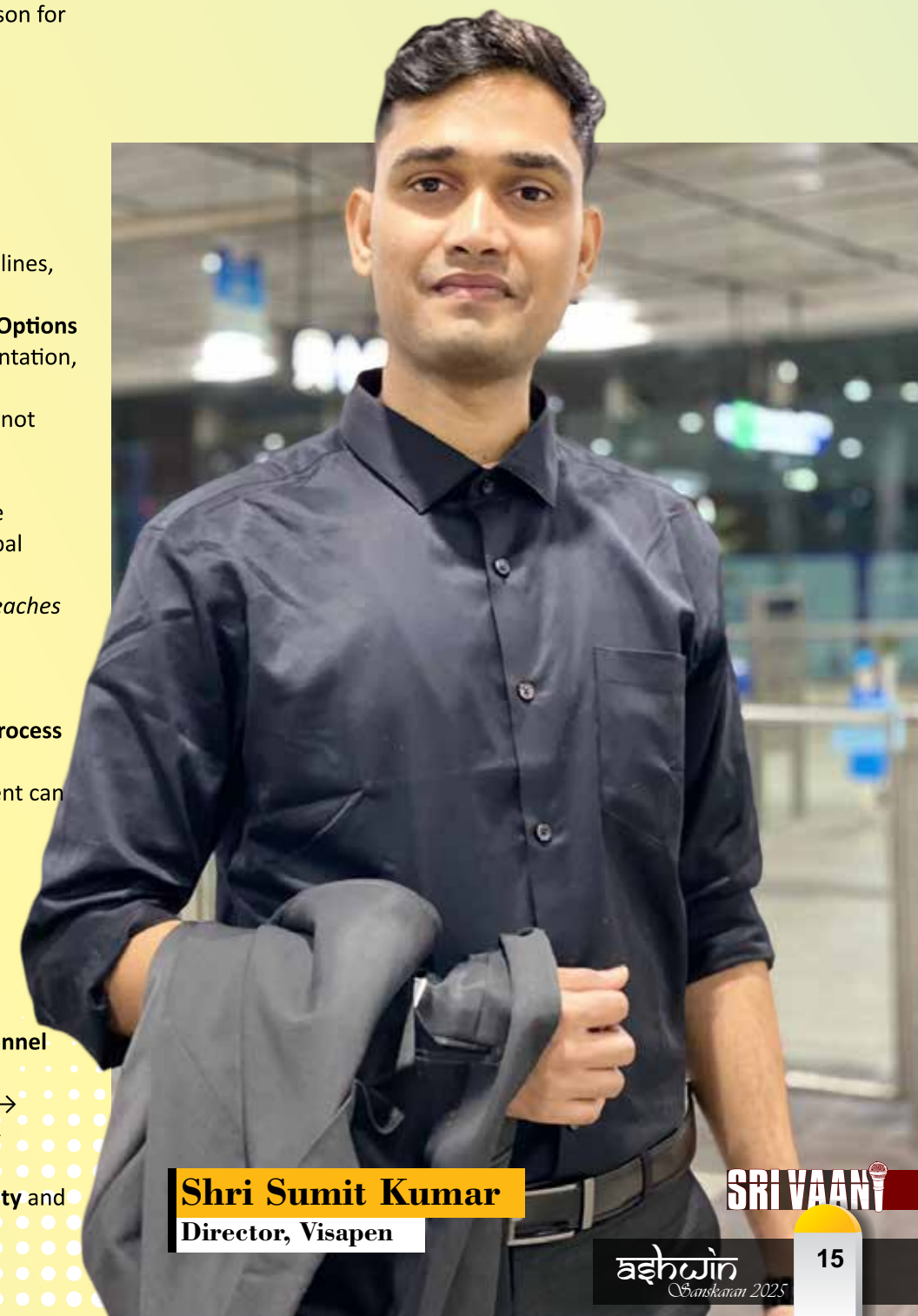
We're thinking big, and the roadmap is ambitious but realistic.

A

1. Germany – Ausbildung 2026–2027 Cohort

We aim to create one of India's largest Ausbildung pipelines with:

- 7–8 months German training
- 100% documented process
- Employer alignments

- Transparent financing

2. Multi-Country EU Workforce Mobility

We are expanding in:

- Poland
- Czech Republic
- Lithuania
- Estonia
- Romania

These countries have massive blue-collar shortages.

Our goal: **Build a verified employer network across Europe.**

3. NBFC + Fintech Integrations

Visapen is building India's first **skill-to-work financing model** — where:

- students train now
- pay later
- and only after earning abroad

This will change the industry permanently.

4. Physical Assessment & Verification Centers

We plan to create centers in 10–15 Indian cities for:

- language classes
- document verification
- skill testing
- offline support

Think of this as a “VFS for work permits.”

5. AI-Based Visa Automation

We are developing in-house tools for:

- visa eligibility detection
- document checks
- employer verification
- compliance scoring

Future goal:

Automated global mobility decisions.

Q

What keeps you motivated during challenging times?

A

I don't rely on motivation; I rely on clarity of my **PURPOSE**. My mental training is the most important aspect of my existence. I'm the summon bonum of what I say to myself, every time whenever I'm between tides of

uncertainties that's called my affirmations.

Whenever challenges come, I remind myself of three things:

1. Armed Forces Mindset

My exposure to the ethos of the Indian Armed Forces taught me discipline, courage, and resilience.

When you've seen tougher situations mentally and

emotionally, industry challenges look manageable.

I don't rely on motivation — I rely on clarity, responsibility, and the willingness to execute.

2. Impact matters more than obstacles.

Every time a student calls and says, “Sir, thank you for giving us clarity,” that one sentence is enough fuel.

3. Hard problems create meaningful work.

Easy things don't create impact.

Difficult things build systems, character, and legacy.

Challenges don't discourage me — they sharpen my strategy.

4. Purpose Over Comfort

I know exactly why Visapen exists — to fix a broken system that affects thousands of families. When your mission is clear, challenges become part of the journey, not obstacles.

Q

What key skills should students develop to succeed in today's professional world?

A

In my experience, three skills are non-negotiable:

1. Become a Person People Can Trust

In today's world, people don't work with you because of degrees or English fluency — they work with you because they **trust your intent, your words, and your consistency**.

Trust is built through:

- doing exactly what you said you would do
- being honest even when the answer is uncomfortable
- taking ownership when things go wrong
- showing reliability over a long period, not 2–3 days

If people feel safe putting their work, time, or career in your hands, then opportunities will come to you naturally.

In simple words:

Be the person others can rely on without second-guessing.

This single quality opens more doors than any certification ever will.

2. Professionalism Through Clarity, Understanding & Clear Thinking

Professionalism is not about wearing formal clothes or using corporate English.

Real professionalism comes from:

- gaining deep understanding of your field
- being clear about what you know and what you don't

- communicating accurately
- respecting timelines
- and approaching problems with maturity

Clarity is a superpower:

When you think clearly, communicate clearly, and execute clearly —

people automatically see you as professional, dependable, and capable of handling responsibility.

In every workplace, the people who grow fastest are not the loudest ones, but the ones who bring **clarity, solutions, and structure** to whatever they touch.

3. The Courage to Execute Fearlessly

Ideas are cheap. Execution builds careers.

Young people today hesitate because of overthinking — “What if I fail?”

“What will people say?”

“What if I am not perfect yet?”

But the truth is:

Fear kills more dreams than failure ever will.

In real life, those who actually move — even when the path is unclear — end up learning faster, attracting opportunities, and staying ahead.

A fearless executor:

- takes initiative
- experiments
- learns from mistakes
- adapts quickly
- and keeps moving without waiting for perfect conditions

The world rewards action-takers, not day-dreamers.

In summary:

To succeed in today's world, focus on becoming:

- **A trustworthy person**
- **A clear, professional thinker**
- **A fearless executor**

These three qualities will not just help you grow in your career —

they will make you someone people remember, respect, and rely on.

Q

If not this profession, what other career path would you have chosen?

A

Although my professional journey has taken me into technology, global mobility, and ecosystem building — my heart has always been deeply connected to the **Armed Forces**.

If life gives me even the last chance, I would always choose the uniform again.

But if not the Armed Forces and not global mobility, I

would naturally gravitate toward fields where technology, people, and problem-solving intersect:

- **Weapon technology**
- **Cyber security**
- **Education innovation**
- **Ecosystem development**

I enjoy building systems that impact thousands of people — so any domain that allows me to combine clarity, structure, and execution would attract me.

Q8. What mantra would you give to students who want to be entrepreneurs?

Entrepreneurship is not a glamorous journey — it's a disciplined one.

My advice to young founders:

1. Start small but start now.

Perfection is overrated. Execution is everything.

2. Solve a real problem.

Not a trending idea — a meaningful one.

****3. Be strong enough to stand alone,**

and humble enough to ask for help.**

4. Clarity is more powerful than motivation.

Know what you're building and why it matters.

5. Stay honest. Stay consistent.

Your character will decide your destiny faster than your idea.

If you build with purpose and execute with courage, success becomes a by-product.



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The Secrets of Effective Time Management

Time is the one resource every individual receives in equal measure 24 hours a day. Yet, some people consistently achieve more, stress less, and maintain better balance than others. The difference lies not in the hours available, but in how those hours are managed. Effective time management is not about doing more things; it is about doing the right things efficiently. Below are the core secrets participated by highly productive individuals.

1. Prioritization: Focus on What Truly Matters

The first and most crucial step in effective time management is understanding the difference between what is *urgent* and what is *important*.

- **Urgent tasks** demand immediate attention but may not contribute to long-term goals.
- **Important tasks** help you grow, progress, and create meaningful results.

Tools like the **Eisenhower Matrix** can help categorize tasks into:

- Do Now
- Schedule
- Delegate
- Eliminate

This ensures that your time aligns with your goals, not just your obligations.

2. Planning with Purpose

A well-planned day is half done.

Daily Planning

Start each morning—or the night before—by listing your top three priorities. These “big rocks” become the must-do tasks of your day.

Weekly Planning

Review the upcoming week to set goals, identify challenges, and allocate time blocks. Weekly planning reduces last-minute stress and improves clarity.

Long-Term Planning

Set monthly and quarterly goals. This ensures your daily tasks feed into a larger direction, eliminating aimless work.

3. Time Blocking: Give Every Minute a Job

Time blocking involves assigning specific time slots for tasks or categories of work.

For example:

- 9:00–10:30 AM: Writing/reporting
- 11:00–12:00 PM: Emails and calls
- 2:00–3:30 PM: Meetings
- 4:00–5:00 PM: Learning or reflection

This method prevents multitasking, protects focus, and improves discipline.

4. The Power of Single-Tasking

Contrary to popular belief, multitasking reduces productivity and increases mistakes. Successful people focus on **one task at a time**, giving it their full concentration. This maximizes efficiency and improves the quality of work.

A useful technique is the **Pomodoro Technique**:

- 25 minutes of focused work
- 5 minutes of break
- Repeat
- After four cycles, take a longer break

5. Learn to Say No Gracefully

Time management is not just about adding tasks; it's also about **protecting your time**. Many people struggle because they accept too

many commitments, invitations, or responsibilities.

Saying no:

- Preserves your energy
- Maintains focus
- Reduces burnout

A polite explanation like, “*I would love to help, but I'm currently committed to another priority,*” can go a long way.

6. Eliminating Distractions

9. Maintain a Healthy Balance

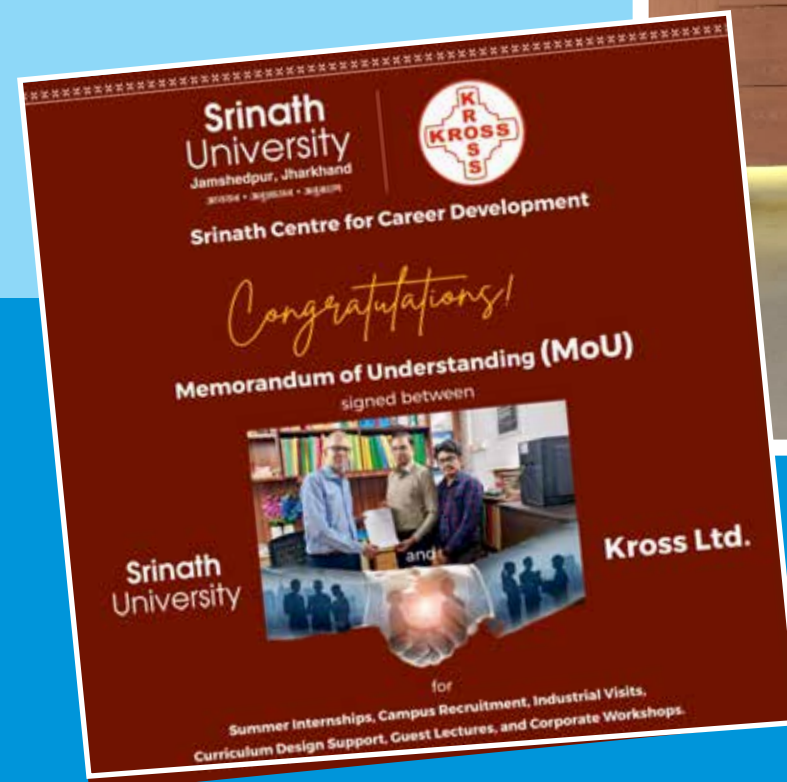
Effective time management isn't just about work—it includes personal time, rest, and recreation. Breaks, proper sleep, and mental relaxation enhance productivity and creativity.

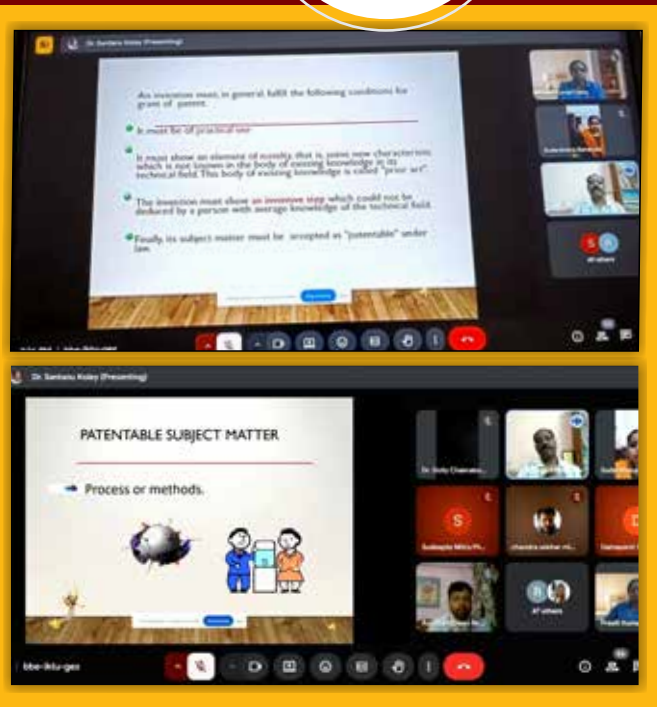

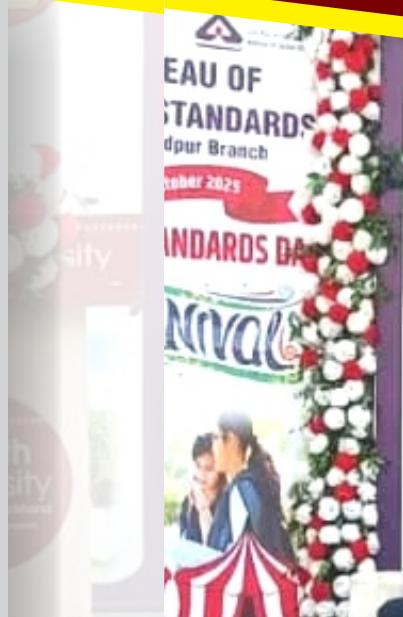
