

In our Shakshaatkar segment, Sumit Kumar, Director at Visapen and a proud alumnus of NIT Jalandhar, shared his perspectives on leadership and technological innovation. With a strong foundation in engineering and a vision for driving purposeful change, he highlighted the importance of adaptability and solution-oriented thinking in today's competitive landscape. His journey reflects the strength of determination and the value of a forward-focused mindset in shaping impactful leadership.

Sir, could you share your professional journey and what inspired you to start Visapen? My professional journey began at NIT Jalandhar,

where four years of engineering didn't just give me a degree—it shaped my mindset. The NIT environment teaches you how to think

analytically, solve problems systematically, and push yourself even when there is no clear instruction manual. These habits stayed with me long after graduation.

After NIT, I spent my few years as an aspirant of Indian Armed Forces and did my contributions too for some glorious days but afterwards I spent years working across travel-tech and global mobility operations. This was the phase that silently built the foundation for Visapen. While working in this field, I repeatedly encountered a very disturbing pattern: young Indians with dreams of working abroad were constantly misled by unregulated agents. Most of them had:

- no awareness of the process
- no idea about documents
- no clarity about employers
- no protection against fraud
- no access to structured training or financing

I interacted with students who had lost lakhs of rupees to fake agents. I met parents who were terrified of the entire "abroad" journey because there was no trustworthy guidance. And I saw talented youth give up on international opportunities simply because they couldn't afford the initial payment.

This is what pushed me to build Visapen.

Visapen didn't come from ambition; it came from

frustration with a broken system and the desire to fix it. I wanted to create a platform where:

- the student is protected
- the process is transparent
- employers are verified
- finances don't become a barrier
- and the entire journey is structured end-to-end

That intention is what became Visapen — a system where global mobility meets ethics, technology, and accessibility.



How did Visapen start, and what vision drives the organization today?

Visapen started with a very simple idea:

Give Indian youth a clear, transparent, step-bystep pathway to work abroad.

Initially, we focused only on documentation assistance. But the demand, the problems we

saw, and the positive responses pushed us to expand aggressively.

Today, Visapen is evolving into a full-stack global mobility ecosystem that integrates:

Language Training Partnerships

A1-B1 level German language programs via verified partners, with LMS and API support.

MEA-Authorized Recruitment Execution

Working with government-authorized organizations like Magic Billion to ensure legal, safe, compliant pathways.

Employer Networks Across Europe

Access to employers in Germany, Poland, Lithuania, Czech Republic, Romania, and more.

NBFC-Backed Financing Models

India's first "train now, pay later" model for global mobility — making international careers financially accessible.

AI-Based Documentation Automation

Reducing human dependency, minimizing errors, and speeding up visa processing.

Academic Pipeline

Partnering with schools, polytechnics, universities, and ITIs to create a structured student funnel.

Our vision is bold and very clear:

To make working abroad accessible to every committed Indian, regardless of their financial background or geographical location.

We want Visapen to become the Zomato of work permits reliable, transparent, and easy to use.



What challenges does the industry currently face, and how is Visapen addressing them?

This industry has deep-rooted problems. Let me break it into three major challenges:

1. Lack of Verified Pathways &

Employer Transparency

Students often depend on WhatsApp messages, verbal promises, and unverified intermediaries. This is the biggest reason for fraud.

How Visapen solves this:

- We work only through MEAauthorized partners.
- Employers are verified and documented.
- Every candidate gets a full transparency sheet with timelines, employer details, and steps.

2. High Upfront Cost & No Financing Options

Language training, visa filing, documentation, and travel require money.

A lot of deserving students simply cannot afford the upfront cost.

How Visapen solves this:

- Tie-ups with NBFCs to provide education-style loans for global mobility.
- EMI starts after the student reaches abroad and starts earning.
- This reduces entry barriers drastically.

3. Lack of Structured Guidance and Process Clarity

There is no single place where a student can understand:

- What documents are needed
- Which country is suitable
- What is the timeline
- What salary to expect
- What are the real risks

How Visapen solves this:



My advice to young founders:




