दुर्गा माता-सी सौम्य -जिसमें शक्ति भी है और करुणा भी।

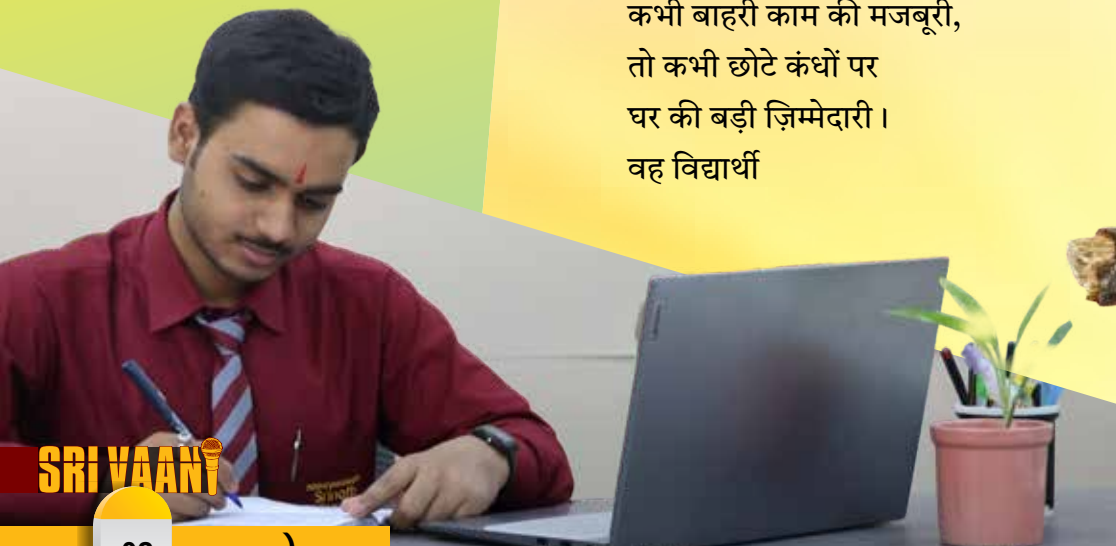

Towards a Digitally and Financially EMPOWERED RURAL INDIA



On the auspicious occasion of 26th January, the NSS Unit of **Srinath University** organized a comprehensive Digital Literacy & Financial Literacy Camp at **Jaspur Village**, Saraikela Kharsawan. 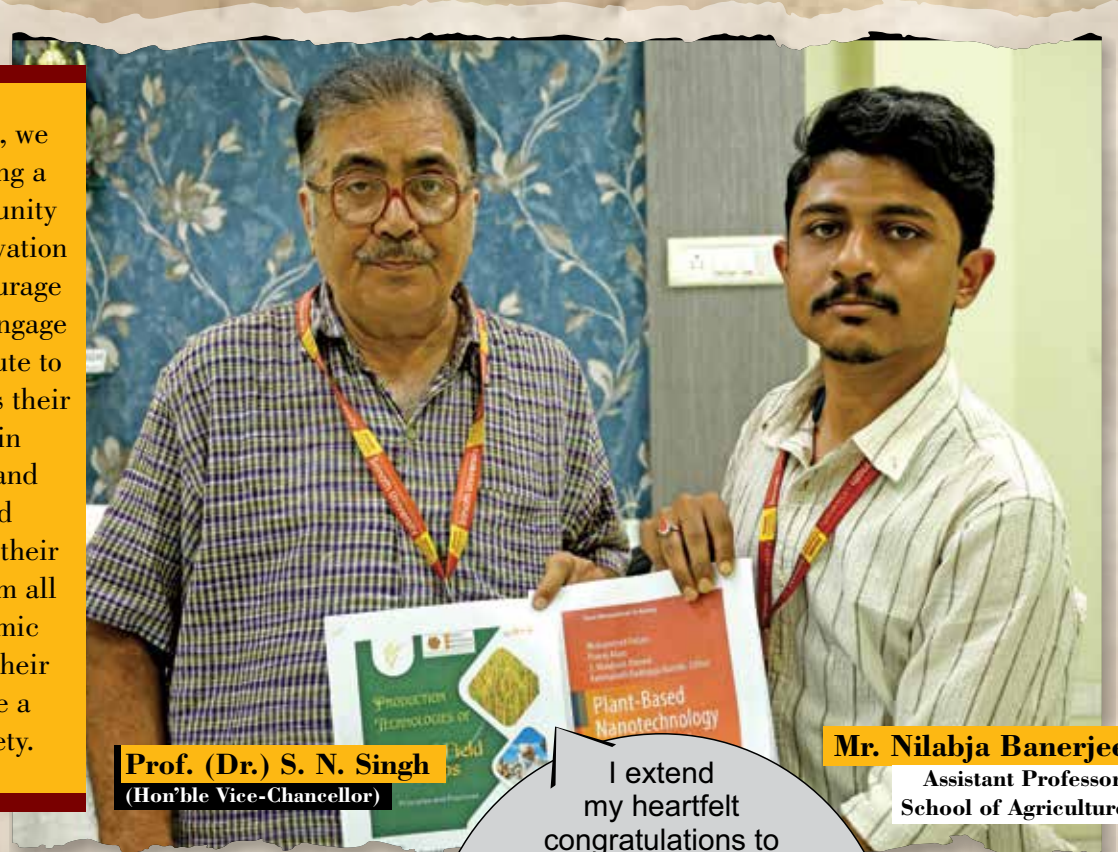

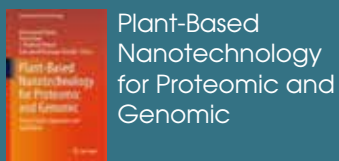

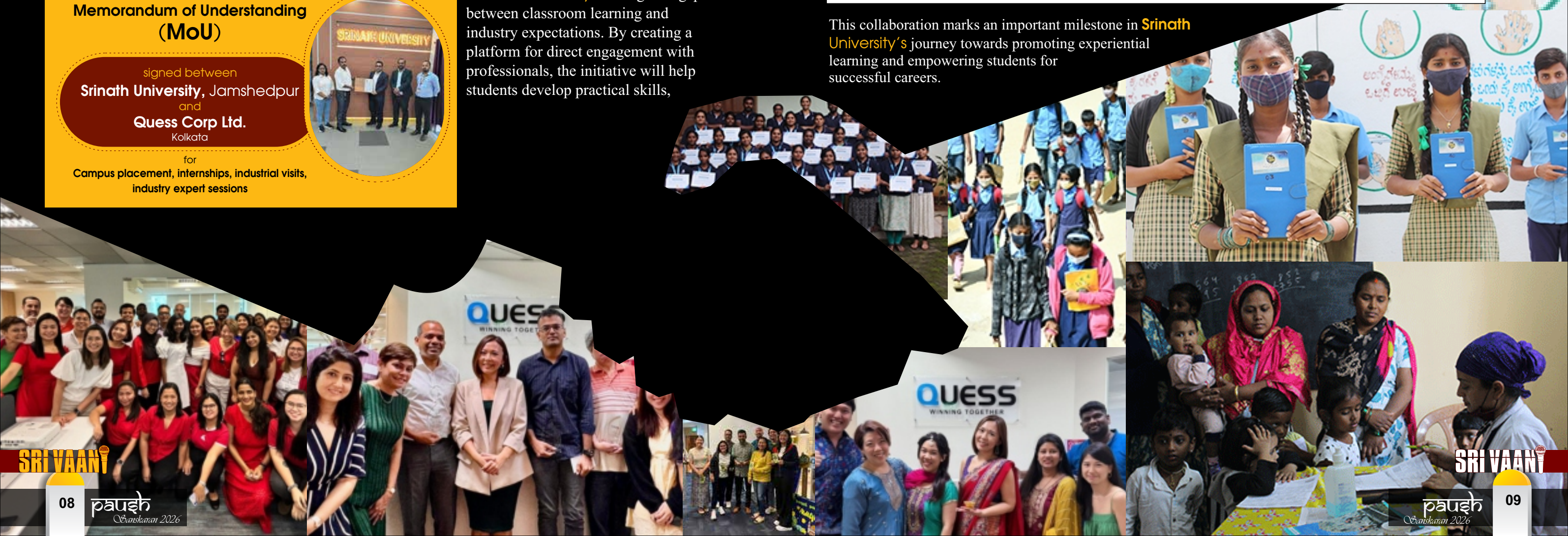

What sparked the idea of Feedko Agrokart, and how did your academic background in business administration guide your entrepreneurial decision?

Q

A

The idea of Feedko Agrokart originated from my early exposure to farming and the persistent issue of price fluctuations in mandis. I realized that the core problem was not production but inefficiencies in the supply chain. My MBA journey helped me analyse logistics, market structures, and supply chain gaps more critically. Instead of pursuing a corporate career, I used my academic learning to design a structured, scalable agri-business model focused on direct market linkage and value chain development.

A

What were the initial challenges you faced while establishing an agri-tech startup in Jharkhand?

One of the biggest challenges was the lack of a strong startup ecosystem in

Jharkhand, with limited access to funding, mentorship, and market credibility outside the state.

At the same time, I believe that the state government of Jharkhand needs to come forward more proactively to support startups, similar to the initiatives taken by the central government. Strong policy implementation, consistent support, and a better funding ecosystem at the state level can significantly boost local entrepreneurship and innovation.

Q

A

What innovative elements in Feedko Agrokart's framework make it stand out in the agricultural supply chain?

Feedko Agrokart stands out due to its complete value chain approach and focus on zero-waste agriculture. Unlike traditional models that only deal with market-grade produce, we ensure that every part of the crop, whether high-quality, damaged, or residue is monetized. We are developing multiple value chains for crop residues like straw, husk, and damaged produce, converting them into useful products such as animal feed, biodegradable goods, and industrial inputs. This holistic and sustainable model differentiates us from conventional supply chains.

Q

A

What are the major challenges faced by small and marginal farmers today, and how does Feedko Agrokart work to resolve them?

Small farmers face challenges such as limited landholding, lack of market access, price volatility, and post-harvest losses. They often do not have the resources or knowledge for optimal crop planning. Feedko Agrokart addresses these issues by providing consultative support, helping farmers choose high-return crops based on season and land size. We also ensure assured market linkage, introduce buyback models, and work on utilizing even damaged produce. Our focus is to minimize risk and maximize income through better planning and market integration.

Q

A

As a founder and CEO, how do you balance entrepreneurship, operations and team management?

I follow a hands-on and relationship-driven leadership approach. In the early stages of any system or process, I stay deeply involved to

understand operational challenges and bottlenecks. At the same time, I treat my team as partners rather than subordinates, which helps build trust and accountability. Balancing entrepreneurship and operations requires adaptability, continuous learning, and strong communication within the team.

Q

A

What is your long-term vision for Feedko Agrokart in Eastern India and beyond?

Our long-term vision is to build a strong and scalable enterprise with a solid presence across Eastern India. We aim to scale our zero-waste value chain model, expand into processing infrastructure, and strengthen national and international market linkages. Key growth areas include sweet corn processing, turmeric value addition, residue-based products, and alternative feed solutions. Ultimately, we want to create a sustainable and inclusive agricultural ecosystem.

A

What advice would you give to students who want to launch startups while still in college?

Students should not wait to complete their degrees to start working on ideas. The college phase is the best time to experiment and learn through practical exposure. Focus on working-based learning rather than only theoretical knowledge. The initial years will involve struggle, uncertainty, and limited resources, but they are crucial for long-term growth. Build networks, gain market exposure, and develop problem-solving skills. Most importantly, treat challenges as opportunities and stay consistent in your efforts.
